1. Construction begins for new Indian embassy building in Bahrain

Dubai, Monday, 9 December 2013

Construction of a new Indian embassy building in Bahrain began with External Affairs Minister Salman Khurshid laying the foundation stone for the US\$7.43 million facility. It will cover approximately 7,800 square meters and will contain a residence for the staff, a library, a consular hall and an auditorium that can accommodate up to 500 people.
