³ Parliamentary elections which were scheduled for 23 September 2014 failed to gain the minimum quorum for elections. It has been rescheduled for 9 October 2014.

⁴ The Lebanese parliament failed to elect a new president due to the lack of constitutional quorum present in the parliament. According to the constitution, two-thirds of the 128-member parliament should be present for the house to convene and elect a Christian Maronite president. However, on 2 September only 57 members were present.

⁵ The elections have been indefinitely postponed.

⁶ This will be the first election of a new Parliament under the 2014 constitution that will replace the Constituent Assembly with a parliament.

⁷ The National Dialogue Conference ended on 21 January 2014. Fresh elections will be held after nine months. Dates are yet to be announced.
